

## **Privacy Policy - Northwest Federal Credit Union Foundation**

The Northwest Federal Credit Union Foundation (“the Foundation is committed to respecting and protecting the privacy of every individual who visits our website, [www.nwfcufoundation.org](http://www.nwfcufoundation.org). We want you to feel confident in how your information is handled. This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect, how we use it, and how we safeguard it.

What information do we collect? The Foundation collects two types of information: personal voluntary information, such as name, email address, phone number, or other details you provide through forms, and non-personal statistical information, such as site traffic, usage patterns, browser type, and general website activity. Non-personal information is collected to help us better understand how visitors use our site and to improve its overall performance and functionality.

How do we use it? This information is used primarily to deliver requested services, respond to inquiries, process event registrations or donations, and improve the design, content, and structure of the site. It may also be used to communicate updates about Foundation programs, events, and initiatives that may be of interest. Information is used only by the Foundation and those who assist in operating our website or supporting our services and will never be sold, rented, or shared with third parties for marketing purposes.

We respect the privacy of every individual who visits our site. We do not collect personally identifiable information from individuals unless it is provided to us voluntarily and knowingly. If you choose to submit information through forms or make a donation, we use the information you supply for the purpose of providing the services or information you have requested. We may also contact you from time to time with information that relates to your interests or engagement with the Foundation.

Security and confidentiality: We take reasonable steps to protect the personal information you provide. Access to personal information is limited to authorized employees, agents, or service providers who require it to perform their responsibilities. While we implement safeguards designed to protect information traveling to, from, and within our website, no method of transmission or storage can be guaranteed to be completely secure.

External links: Our website may contain links to other websites. The Foundation is not responsible for the privacy practices or content of those external sites.
